FR MICHAEL'S REFLECTION ON LENT AND THE NEW FINANCIAL YEAR

Lent is an opportunity for us to reflect on where the Lord is in our lives. It is also the time when we come to the new financial year. As we come to the year end it is time to renew our parish finances. Over the past several years the Diocese has supported us around £20000, at the end of April I will publish the accounts for this year with a comparison for the past few years. About half of the subsidy each year from the Diocese is covered by the Gift Aid claimed from your donations. Over the coming months we also need to think about costs which can be cut along with an increase in giving to begin to tackle that deficit. Ways to help can be to consider increasing your weekly contribution even if just by £1 or £2; an easy way is if you do not already Gift Aid then please consider doing so. We are also facing an increase in bank charges; therefore, we are being encouraged to have people contribute more by either Standing Order or contactless using either the Dona station at Our Lady's or online.
